NOTICE OF RACE

The J70 Spanish Open – Ribeira Sacra Trophy, is organized by the Real Club Náutico de Vigo (RCNV) in conjunction with the Spanish J70 Owners Association, in June from 1-3, 2018

1.- Rules

1.1: The regatta will be governed by

- a) The rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS 2.017-2020)
- b) The rules of the International J/70 Class
- c) The notation '[DP]' in a rule in this NoR means that the penalty for a breach of that rule may, at the discretion of the protest committee, be less than disqualification.

1.2 If there is a conflict between languages the Spanish text will take precedence.

2.- Advertising [DP]

2.1 Advertising shall only be displayed in accordance with Regulation 20 – World Sailing Advertising Code

2.2 Boats shall be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the Organizing Authority (OA), in accordance with World Sailing Regulation 20 and J/70 Class rules. If provided, flags, stickers and decals shall be displayed from the close of check-in through the end of the regatta. Bow numbers, stickers and flags will be supplied to each boat by the OA.

3.- Entries

3.1 The boats must present a sticker/card class, measuring certificate and crew members have a sport license 2018.

3.2 The regatta is open (all nationality) to all boats of the J/70 class

3.3 **Required fees** in J70 Spanish Open, are **150 €** (it includes the boat parking in the RCNVigo to the European Championship), that must be entered in the account of the Spanish J/70 Owners Association, before May, 30th 2018 to:

3.4 A copy of the boat's liability insurance must be submitted and proof of payment of the registration fees in the race.

- 3.5 Non-spanish sportsman/sportswoman, will must prove that they have a valid accident and sickness insurance in Spain
- 3.6 The number of crew members cannot be changed in each race. In the race that it is detected by the judges, umpires or officers any boat infringing this rule, it will be automatically penalized with a point in each of the racings in which it has been observed infringing the rule.

4.- Schedule

- 4.1 The program will be

- 4.2 On the last scheduled day of racing no warning signal will be made after 14:00 hours.
- 4.3 There are 8 scheduled races, and 2 must be completed for the validity of the regatta
- 4.4 A maximum of 4 races on any day may be sailed, except if the race Committee deems it appropriate to do more races.

5.- Inspections and Measurements

- 5.1 Only one set of Sails may be used at each regatta.
- 5.2 An additional SPI, sealed, can be carried at boat.
- 5.3. All boats may be weighed before going down to the water.
- 5.4. At the end of each racing, the race committee will be able to check the first three classified in the sea, and when arriving at the shore, to which they are indicated by draw.

6.- Sailing Instructions

- 6.1 The sailing instructions will be available after May 30th, 12:00 hours.

7.- Event Format and Scoring

- 7.1 All boats will sail as one fleet.
- 7.2 The low-point scoring system RRS, will apply, and:
 - 7.2.1 When 6 or more races have been completed, a boat's score will be the total of her race scores, excluding her worst score.

8.- The Courses

- 8.1 The courses to be sailed will be windward / leeward, described in the sailing instructions.

9.- Radio Communication

- 9.1 Radio Communication Channel 71 VHF.
- 9.2 Except in an emergency, a boat that is racing shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication that is not available to all boats. [DP]

10.- Prizes

- 10.1 The prize list will be exhibited in the TOA after the first race

11.- Image rights

- 11.1 When entry form is accepted, the participants automatically assign to the organising committee the rights of Image, recorded or filmed during the event, as defined by the notice of race and the sailing instructions, in perpetuity, being able to make use Of them at any time without the participants being able to request any compensation.

12.- Disclaimer of Liability

- 12.1 Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race.
- 12.2 The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
